#### **DEFINITIONS AND ACRONYMS:**

D&A: acronym- stands for 'drugs and alcohol'.

**Detox/Withdrawal management:** Withdrawal management is the short-term medical and psychological care of a person experiencing withdrawal symptoms as a result of stopping or reducing use of their drug of dependence. Withdrawal management may also be known as detoxification or detox, and is provided in outpatient, inpatient and residential settings.

**Dual diagnosis:** The term dual diagnosis refers to one or more diagnosed mental health problems occurring at the same time as problematic drug and alcohol use. A dual diagnosis condition can include: a mental health problem or disorder leading to or associated with problematic alcohol and/or other drug use.

**Abstinence based approach:** An abstinence-based approach means that clients must completely abstain from drugs and alcohol while in the rehabilitation facility. Usually abstinence based programs will not accept people on the methadone/suboxone program and may not accept people on other prescribed medications.

#### SUGGESTED SEARCHABLE TERMS

This list was created with the intention for people to be able to search the following terms to be able to quickly find the correct services for them. Some suggested searchable terms are as follows:

- Women only: searching this term will highlight services that cater specifically to women and do not accept men
- Men only: searching this term will highlight services that cater specifically to men and do not accept women
- **Aboriginal**: searching this term will highlight services specifically for or with a focus on first nation people
- **Children**: searching this term will highlight services where mother's may be able to complete the program whilst caring for their children
- **Dual diagnosis:** searching this term will highlight services where people with both drug/alcohol addition and mental health conditions can receive appropriate treatment
- Will accept clients directly from custody: searching this term will highlight services that will take client's straight from custody
